The following is an example of a family who received services. Nancy (not her real name) and her two children became homeless after she separated from her partner. Her family was supportive but she could not stay with them. Nancy was working part-time when she entered the shelter. During her stay, Nancy found a full-time job with benefits and obtained an additional part-time job. She started working with Consumer Credit Counseling Services to pay off past debt and used her tax refund to purchase a car. The family moved into Bridges to Housing Stability temporary housing. Nancy will be able to save money and continue to work on her debt. Having reliable transportation will allow Nancy to get to work and daycare. She will also be able to widen her search for affordable housing.

People will continue to obtain stable housing because of your support. Thank you again for your thoughtfulness.


Thank you very much for your generous donation of \$285 in gift cards. The gift cards will be distributed to families and individuals in the shelter programs for food and basic necessities.

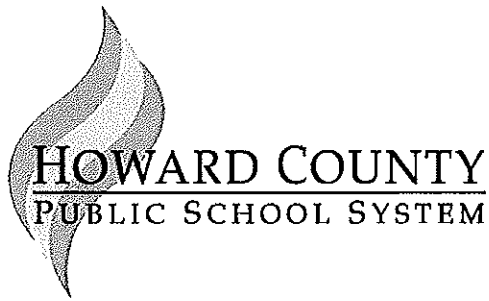

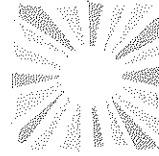

On behalf of Grassroots I want to thank you for your donation of food. We are always in need of meals for the shelter residents. We also appreciated your help with serving the meal.

The following is an example of a person who was provided with shelter and support services. Adam had been homeless for three years and staying from place to place. He was estranged from his family and was grieving the deaths of two sons. He had significant health issues, a history of addictions, and depression. Adam was in need of hip replacement surgery but did not have the insurance to cover that. He also needed significant dental work before he could be cleared for surgery. His condition deteriorated during his stay from walking unassisted to needing a wheelchair. Our volunteer physician found a surgeon who would do the hip replacement and Adam spent months getting the needed dental work. Adam received a housing voucher and located an apartment to rent. He also started receiving SSI while in the shelter and obtained Medical Assistance. Adam's hip surgery was successful and he is recuperating in his own home.
